WRITER GUIDELINES

- Fall/Winter Issue Deadline April 30th :: Spring/Summer Issue Deadline November 29
- Articles sent after the deadline will be placed in the next issue.
- Articles must be original and are subject to editing for clarity and grammar. Do not format (no indents or double spacing, etc.)
- Articles must be experience-based and not crafted as a product promotion unless solicited. We do not want research content writers.
- We prioritize articles that aren't ideologically limiting as we desire to encourage homesteaders in whatever location or walk of life they find themselves in.
- Photos must be quality, high-resolution .jpeg or .nef format. We may edit for clarity or crop to fit. Bio boxes may include self-promotion and products. Please include hyperlinks for the digital version of the magazine.
- Writers are compensated at time of printing. Rates are negotiable depending on expertise and quality.
- We do not have time to reply to follow-up inquiries on submissions.






